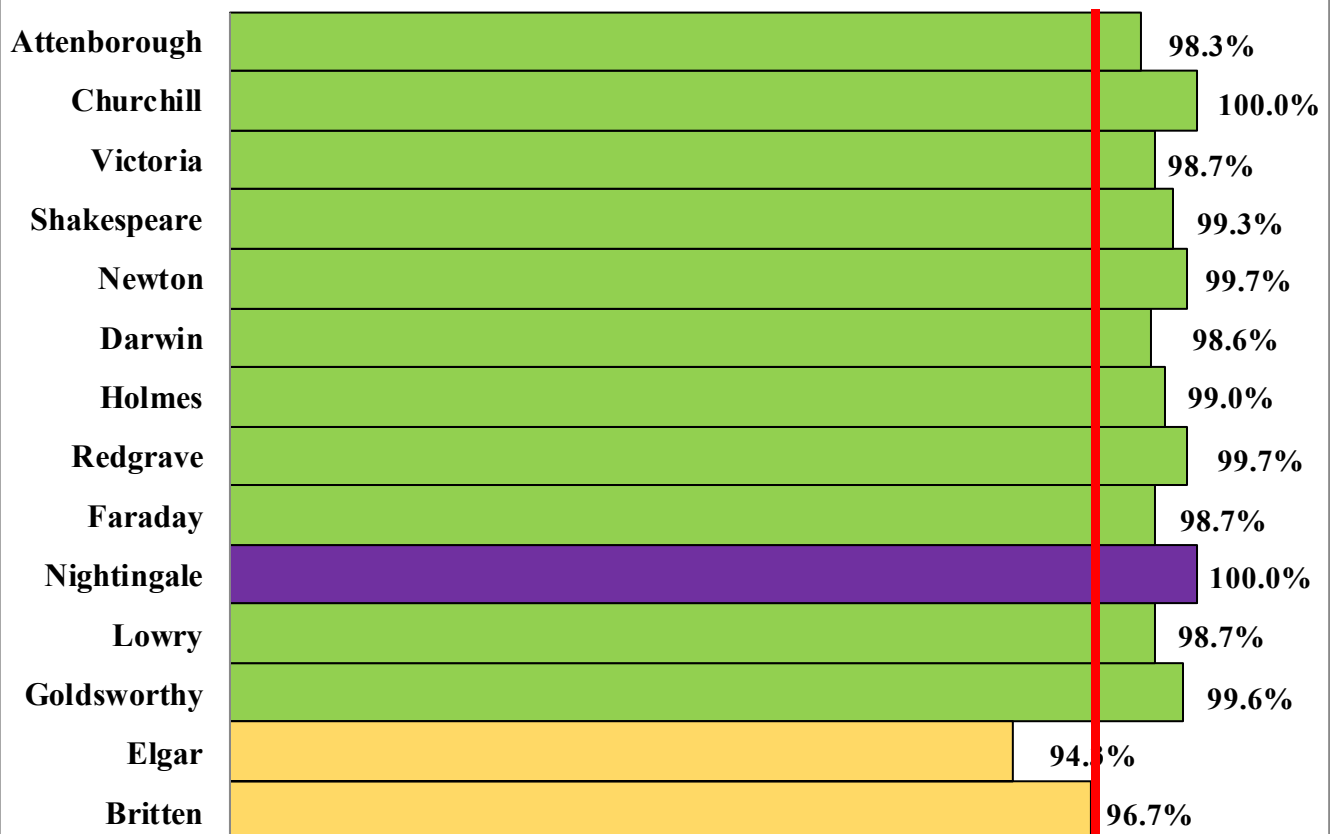

We are really pleased to say that we have been able to secure another coach and can now open up the club to more children.

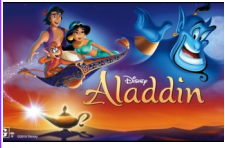
Priority will be given to those children who had already asked to take part but weren't able to get a place at the start of the term, and other places will be allocated after that.
