Dear Parents

It was wonderful to see so many families attend our 'Open Classrooms' on Wednesday. It is always a popular event and the children are always so proud to show off their classrooms and share their work. There was a real buzz around the school and I am sure you were all impressed with what you saw and how hard the children have been working this term.

Thursday morning saw our first year group assembly of the year with Newton and Darwin classes sharing their fantastic adventures from their residential trip to Sayers Croft. It was clear how much they had enjoyed the trip and learned many new skills. There were so many highlights for them and they clearly relished every minute - I am sure would do it all again in a flash if they could! Thank you to the Year 4 teachers for organising the assembly as well as giving up their time to ensure the children had such an unforgettable experience on the trip, growing in both confidence and independence.



Green was the colour of the day in school on Wednesday as the school showed our support for Cerebral Palsy day, recognising a condition shared by two of the children at our school. Together, we recognised differences between ourselves and others, and how crucial it is that we do not let or differences limit our achievements. It was a positive day, focusing on what we can all do and using our two 'super heroes' as examples of determination for us all.

This year wellbeing remains high on our school's agenda as part of our school development plan. With this is mind, next week on Wednesday, 16th October we are asking children and staff to wear one item of yellow clothing to support the work done by the charity YoungMinds. One of the key goals of YoungMinds is to ensure that children and young adults receive the best possible mental health support and have the resilience to overcome life's difficulties. We will talk to the



children about #HelloYellow day during the whole school Assembly on Monday morning and teachers will be delivering PSHE lessons focusing on wellbeing and good mental health later in the week.

Last year we trialled replacing the Parent Focus Group meetings with a Parent Pop in afternoon to widen the group of parents coming forward with feedback, ideas and suggestions about what was going well as well as proposals for improvement. We will be holding a Coffee Morning with myself and Mrs Crawford on Wednesday 16th October from 8:45am to 9:30am and would love to see as many parents as possible to find out what you think is going well and any ways you think we could do even better. We look forward

to seeing you there. We will hold subsequent meetings at different times to try and attract as many people as possible.

One final reminder, now that we are well and truly in Autumn and the weather is so unpredictable and varied, please ensure your child brings a coat to school every day as we do Follow us on try to make sure the children get outside in the @Southfield_Park fresh air wherever possible.






Attendance this week

If your child wants to change their meal pattern for the next half term, please let us know before the end of this half term (Friday 25th October), and note that the kitchen will be changing to the new Winter menu at that time; we hope to let you know what the new menu is soon. A pattern can be school meals every day, packed lunch every day, or a mix of the two, but they must be on the same pattern every week, so for example a flexi pattern could be a school dinner on Wednesday and Thursday, and a packed lunch on Monday, Tuesday and Friday, but the pattern must stay the same each week, for the complete half term.

All children have the main dinner, unless a suitable alternative is required, and in addition:

Monday: Y5 & Y6 can choose at the servery hatch to have a cheesy pasta pot

Tuesday: Y6 will be asked if they want the main meal or a panini

Thursday: Y6 will be asked if they want the main meal or a panini

Friday: Y5 & Y6 can choose at the servery hatch to have a tomato pasta pot, with optional meatballs or sausage, depending on the week


