Whilst the last few months have been so tricky for everyone one of the real positives has been how we have come together as a school community, reinforcing what makes Southfield Park such a special place to be. 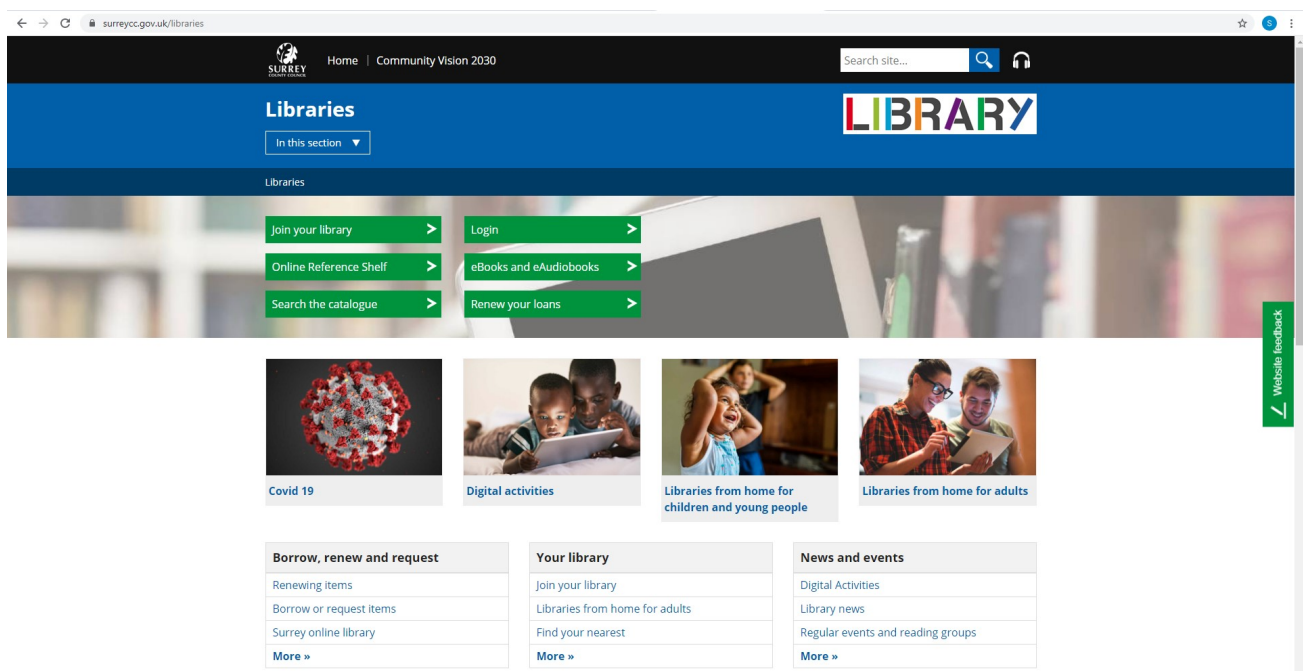
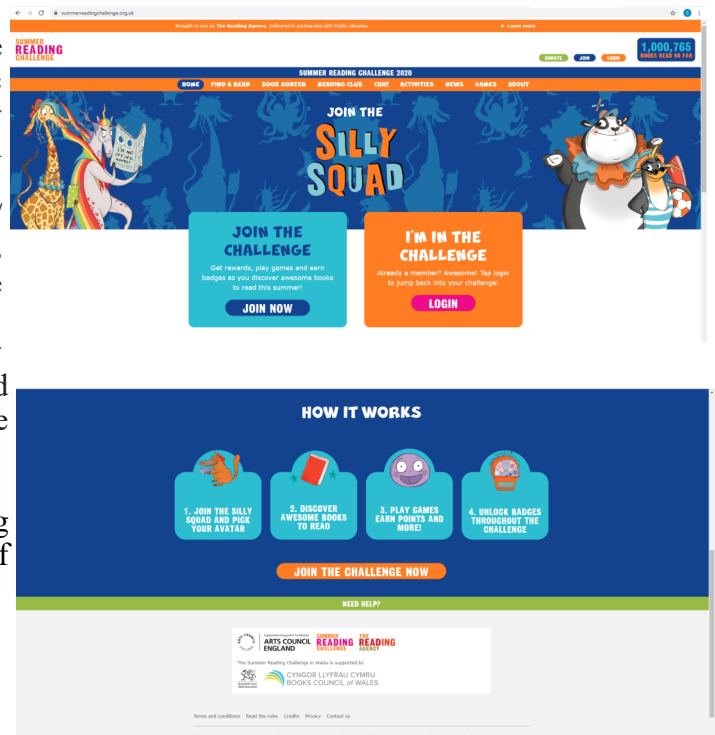
