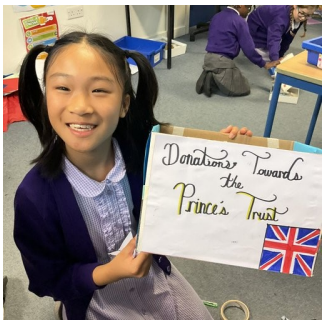


Newsletter 17 19/05/2023

I am finishing today with some lovely news: Miss David and her partner are expecting a baby in the autumn. We are absolutely delighted for them. Congratulations.

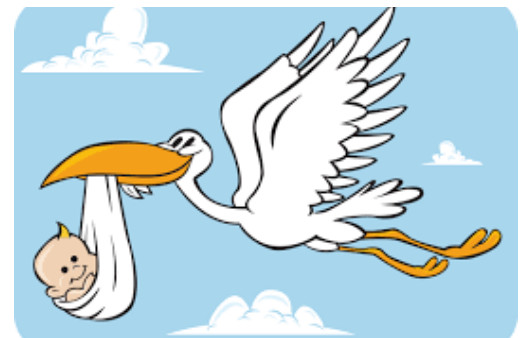

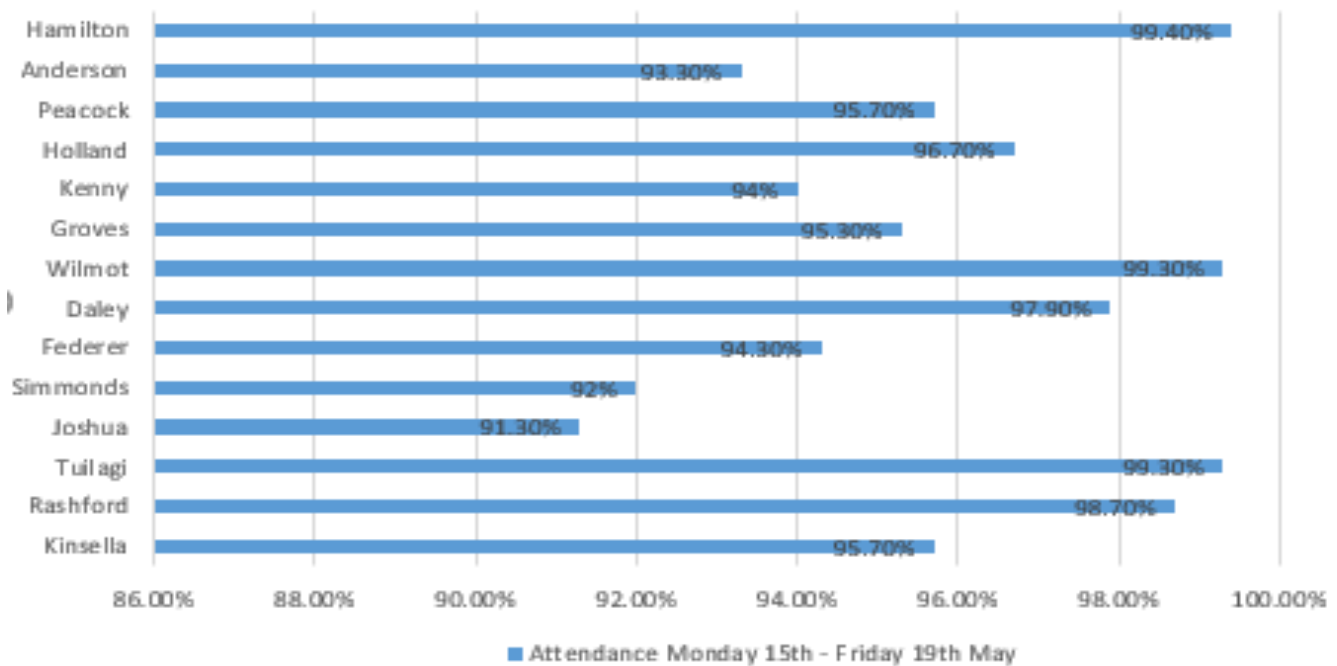


Attendance




